Bridging the national and local/regional approaches

(ideas from earlier discussions)

- Interest from SH to participate at the events and willingness for cooperation
 - there could be a working group or a committee coming together once a quarter or once a year.
 - there should be someone who initiates, leads, and facilitates the cooperation process e.g., organizing joint events
- It would be good to start with cross-border joint planning of activities especially when elaborating local /regional development plans to coordinate actions for the whole river basin.
 - Local action groups could help to sustain such cooperation as being most interested in gathering all relevant parties at a round table
- Cooperation can continue in frame of follow-up projects
- Cooperation on expert level is not enough, there should be a political will to take a decision for cooperation, e.g., approval of the River basin management plan by the government



SH agreement in Lielupe RB – preliminary ideas

- Main topic: water quality issues in the Lielupe RB
- Format: working group meetings, local practical actions
- To get involved: River Basin Authorities (LV/LT), National, Regional and Local level stakeholders
- Enabling conditions: approach to support informal agreement
- Focal point: BEF (until the year 2028 in frame of Horizon project NATALIE)

initiates, leads, and facilitates the cooperation process e.g., organizing joint events

NEPAT - to extract the focus areas for the agreement

- NEPAT training session on how to use the tool until August 2024
- SH workshop to show initial results of NEPAT October/ November 2024
- Update governance roadmaps, refine draft with SH individually November
 2024 until March 2025
- SH workshop to show updated results of NEPAT, roadmap, sign agreements –
 March 2025

Signing the cooperation agreement can be in synergy with local practical activities, e.g., «Cleaning the river day»

Ideas for practical activities

- Water quality issues to trigger the cooperation in real life and improve the water quality in the whole Lielupe River basin
- To bridge national and local/regional level approaches
- Discussion in working groups on transboundary cooperation needs and practical activities (Latvia/Lithuania):
 - at various levels national/regional/local
 - form of cooperation e.g., meetings, study visits, river cleaning, Lielupe festival
 - topics data exchange, nature-based solutions, river basin planning activities, approach and methodology
